Accompanying them were six members of the district's new Rapid Support Team (RST), a cadre of volunteer employees who receive extra training enabling them to quickly deploy in support of a public health emergency response. The exercise involved sweeping a mass gathering venue for potentially harmful items. Participants agreed the exercise provided an outstanding training experience and significantly improved their confidence in conducting such sweeps.
